

We're making some changes to the residential permit scheme

We use permits to prevent our Household Waste Recycling Centres being used by non – Wakefield residents. If you plan to use any of the centres in a car or with a trailer smaller than 6ft x 4ft, you are required to display a permit, ideally in your car windscreen before entry.

From Wednesday 31 October 2018, permits that look like this will no longer be accepted at any of our Household Waste Recycling Centres



You will need to replace it with one like this



If you have this kind of permit you can still use it to access the Household Waste Recycling Centres



To replace your permit, you can:

- **Apply via on our online system at**

- **Visit any of the HWRCs at Wakefield, Glasshoughton or South Kirkby**
You will need to provide proof of residency in the district i.e. recent utility bill, driving licence or council tax bill. No older than 6 months. Once these details have been checked and verified you will be issued with a permit.
- **Speak to the Contact Centre on 03458 506 506 who can arrange for a permit to be sent out in the post.**

Please dispose of your out of date permit or alternatively hand it in at the Household Waste Recycling Centre. Customers displaying an old version of the permit after the 31st October 2018 will be required to obtain a new one and may be prevented from using this site.
